Explore fun tie-dye techniques of folding, twisting and binding fabrics with rubber bands, pennies, thread, clips and clothespins. Students might want to bring to a pre-washed T-shirt or old clothing items to repurpose for reuse. We are using fiber-reactive dyes that work well with a high content of plant fibers such as cotton, rayon and linen. Prayer flags & cotton hankies with be provided. All ages

This class can be instructional or used as an open studio! Learn the basic techniques of glass construction to make your stained glass masterpiece.
