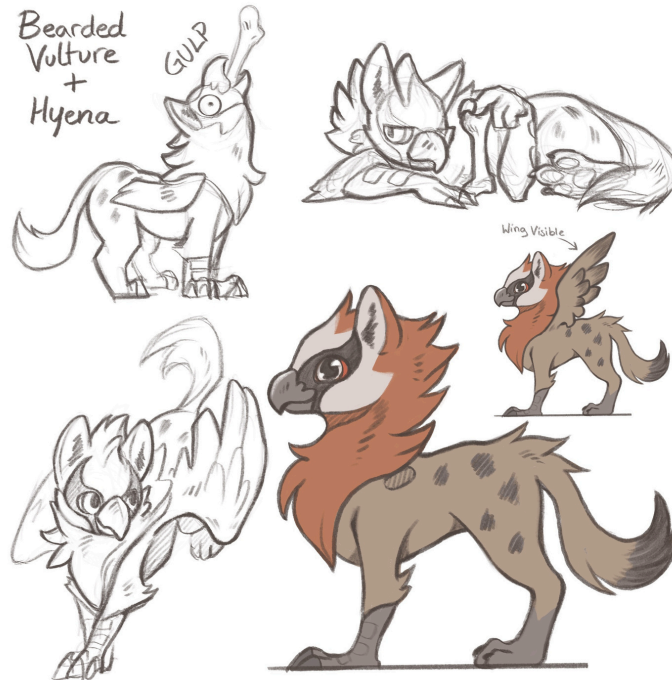
## Concept Art and Design

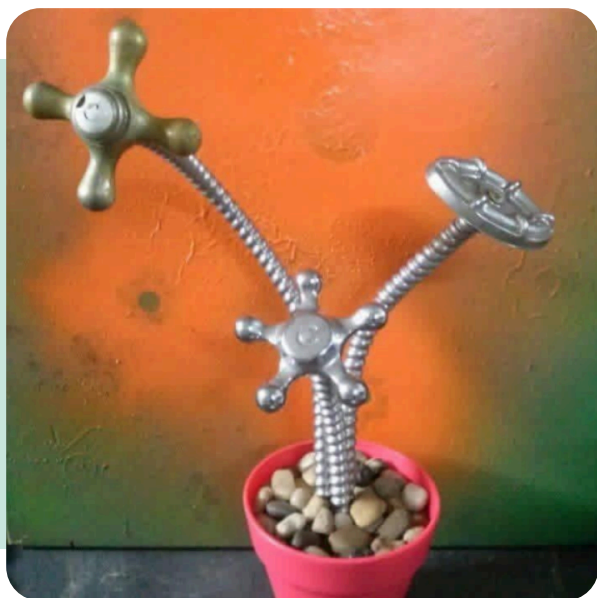

In this class we'll upcycle aseptic cartons into intaglio printmaking plates by scoring, sanding, and peeling away layers of the carton. Play with a variety of inking techniques to print multiples of your image on a small etching press. Ages 12+.



## Sashiko

with Tessa Hughes

July 24th 6pm-8pm

Learn the basics of sashiko, a traditional Japanese stitching technique known for its simple, repeating patterns. In this beginner-friendly class, participants will practice hand-stitching linework and geometric designs using embroidery thread to create decorative and functional pieces. Basic techniques and patterns will be taught. Needles, embroidery thread, and patchwork materials will be provided. Please bring a piece to mend (something sturdy, like denim or canvas); demo pieces will also be available.

## Pet Portrait Painting

with Chantel Lynch

July 25<sup>th</sup> 10am-12pm

Learn the fundamentals of watercolor while honoring a furry friend! In this 2-hour session, students will learn essential techniques like wet-on-wet blending, layering, and fine-detail brushwork. While the class is structured around technical milestones, students will have full creative choice over their color palettes and composition to capture their pet's unique personality. Ages 12+.



# AUGUST



## ***Fabric Storyscape*** ***with Julie Olsen*** *Aug 1st 9am-12pm*

Piece together a fabric storyscape using applique quilting method with brightly colored fabrics. We will embellish your storyscapes with stitching, beads and sequins. Ages 12+.

## ***Bug Hotels*** ***with Wren Sands*** *Aug 7th 6pm-8pm*

Create a cozy home for your native pollinators! Students will be provided with houses that they can decorate and stuff with reeds for bugs to live in. Ages 12+





## **Botanical Printmaking**

**with Jean Upton**

*Aug 8th 10am-12pm*

Learn the art of creating natural prints using plants and leaves. Explore acrylic paint techniques.

Use ink, print, color, cut-out, and Jean's bird stamps to create a bird collage.

Ages 10+.

## **Moss Embroidery**

**with Chantel Lynch**

*Aug 22nd 10am-12pm*

Step beyond traditional flat stitching into the world of 3D fiber art. In this workshop, we will explore the process of creating a moss bed using embroidery, floss, beading, and real wood elements. Students will learn foundational 3D embroidery techniques, including creating underlays and building realistic textures through French knots and Turkey Work. This is a choice-based workshop where students can design their own mini-ecosystem while learning professional finishing techniques. Ages 16+.



## **Stained Glass**

*Aug 29th 9am-4pm*

This class can be instructional or used as an open studio. Learn the basic techniques of glass construction to make your stained glass masterpiece. Should you be a beginner or have advanced skills, this class is for you. Finished piece goes home with you that day. Patterns provided or bring your own. Ages 12+.
